

WHAT DOES ROADRUNNER FINANCIAL, INC. ("RF") DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- · Social Security number, income and contact information
- · account balances, payment history and transaction history
- · vehicle Information and credit information

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons RF chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Our joint marketing partners may include dealerships with which we have a business relationship, other financial companies and original equipment manufacturers.		

Other Important Information

California and Vermont Residents: We will not share your information with companies outside of RF and its affiliates, except for our everyday business purposes, for marketing our products and services to you, or as required or permitted by law or with your consent.

Texas Residents: RF is licensed and examined under the laws of the State of Texas and by state law is subject to regulatory oversight by the Office of Consumer Credit Commissioner.
